Title One Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program is a Government program. You are responsible to verify your own eligibility. **The Reading program requires a full semester (16 week) practicum that will meet at an earlier time at a local elementary school. During the practicum, students will also take one 8 week course. Students may be required to attend class two nights a week during the term that the two courses run concurrently. †The Doctoral, School Counseling, Illinois Principal Preparation Program and MAT programs may require a different schedule and completion time. GRE or Miller Analogies test required for Doctoral program
