

**OBJECTIVE**: Create a mixed media artwork that shows the illusion of space by having a main focal image expanding beyond the border.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Choose your SUBJECT MATTER (examples could be birds, animals, sea creatures, fish, mythical creatures).
- 2. Draw a sketch (a pencil drawing) of your idea. Make it very detailed! This is your first or rough draft.
- 3. When your idea is approved by the teacher, then you will receive your final paper to start your project.
- 4. Begin LIGHTLY drawing your interior rectangle by measuring 2" from each side of the paper.
- 5. Draw your main subject matter LIGHTLY!
- 6. Draw in your background images LIGHTLY, only extending park of the image to the edges of the paper. (for example, vines, tree branches, flowers)
- 7. Use watercolor pencils to color in only the main image of your artwork and the rectangle.
- 8. Use black permanent markers to fill in the area outside of the rectangle using pen and ink techniques.
