The COVID-19 health crisis has shed light on the need for home internet service, and the large number of American households in all kinds of communities who don't have it. Some Internet Service Providers have responded with new or improved discount broadband plans, that will only be available for a short time; others continue to offer plans that were created prior to the crisis. NDIA commits to keeping this list of Free & Low-Cost Internet Plans updated daily.

Which offers are included in this list?

To support local efforts, NDIA has compiled a list of current offers from ISPs that will help low-income households to acquire service at low or no cost. Most have eligibility limitations linked to income or program enrollment. The list also includes established, nationally available low-cost plans offered by nonprofit organizations. We will add other providers' plans as we learn of them.

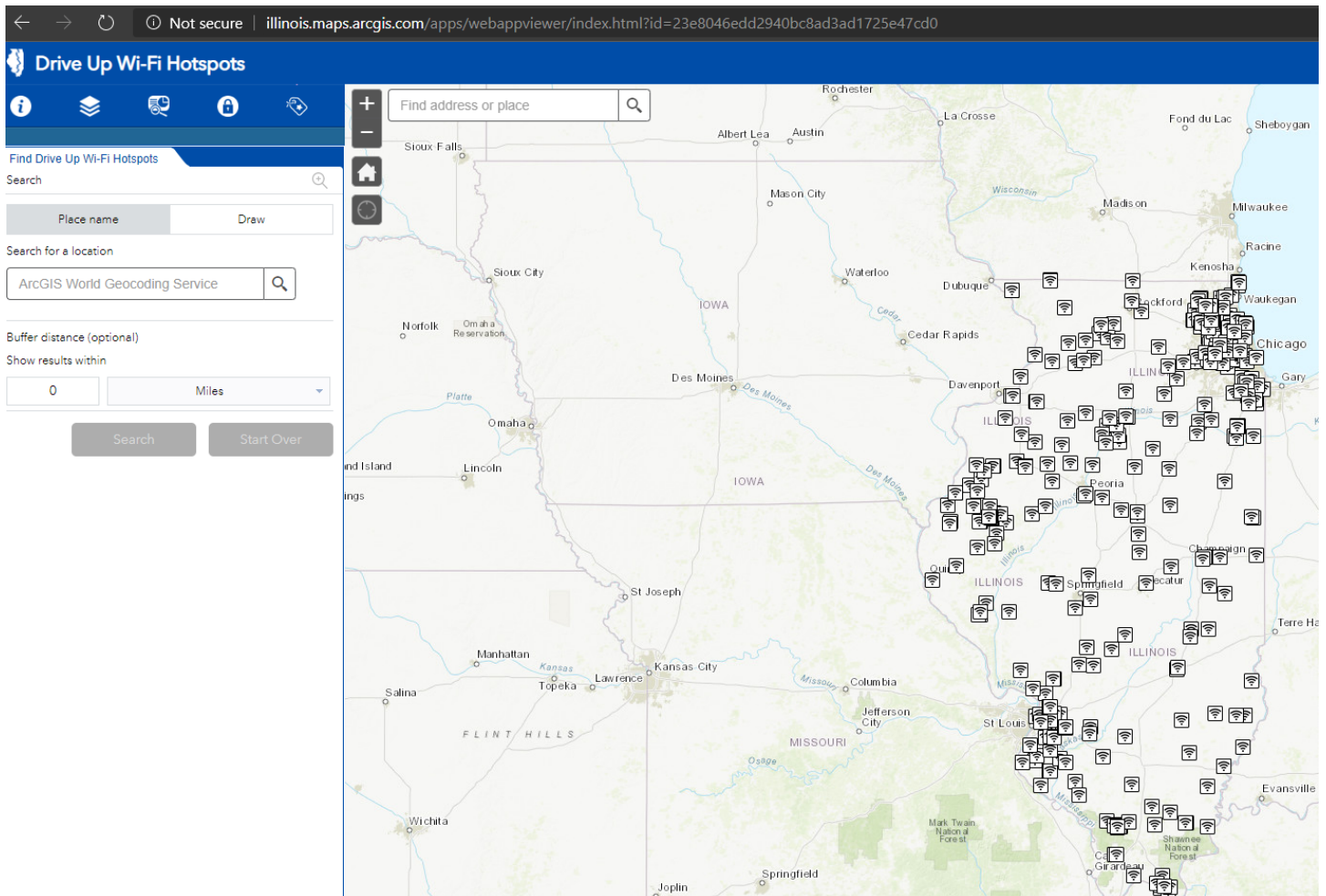

La crisis de salud de COVID-19 ha arrojado luz sobre la necesidad de un servicio de Internet en el hogar y la gran cantidad de hogares estadounidenses en todo tipo de comunidades que no lo tienen. Algunos proveedores de servicios de Internet han respondido con planes de banda ancha con descuento nuevos o mejorados, que solo estarán disponibles durante un período breve; otros continúan ofreciendo planes que fueron creados antes de la crisis. NDIA se compromete a mantener actualizada diariamente esta lista de planes de Internet gratuitos y de bajo costo.

¿Qué ofertas se incluyen en esta lista?

Para apoyar los esfuerzos locales, NDIA ha compilado una lista de ofertas actuales de los ISP que ayudarán a los hogares de bajos ingresos a adquirir servicios a bajo costo o sin costo alguno. La mayoría tiene limitaciones de elegibilidad relacionadas con los ingresos o la inscripción al programa. La lista también incluye planes de bajo costo establecidos y disponibles a nivel nacional ofrecidos por organizaciones sin fines de lucro.
